Situated in a mature, elevated and private setting within this well-regarded road on the fringes of Bury St Edmunds, Hillside is an individual detached bungalow, built in the 1930s of traditional construction under a newly installed pan-tiled roofline.

The property has been updated over the last 2 years, to include updated bathroom and cloakroom, whilst benefitting from a high degree of natural light and well-proportioned rooms. Of note is the wonderful setting, in what feels like a peaceful 'village lane' yet having the convenience of the town centre on the doorstep.

Arranged on one single floor, the accommodation comprises glazed uPVC entrance porch leading to a sitting room with large window to the west. The dining room faces east, with windows and door to the garden, painted fireplace and picture rails.

The kitchen is fitted with a range of storage units with worktop, ceramic sink with drainer, tiled floors, door to the side garden, large pantry cupboard and cloakroom.

There are three good-sized bedrooms, two of which have built-in wardrobes, whilst being served by a newly installed and extended bathroom, with walk-in shower, separate bath, vanity wash basin and low-level WC.

Outside

Hillside is approached a long driveway which leads to an extensive parking area and garage. There is a path leading through the wonderful mature gardens which host many specimen trees to include sweet chestnut, magnolia, walnut, eucalyptus, oak, and maple.

The path continues to the house, by a lawned garden, and continues around to the front garden, which hosts many shrubs and beds, with path down to a gate giving access to the road.

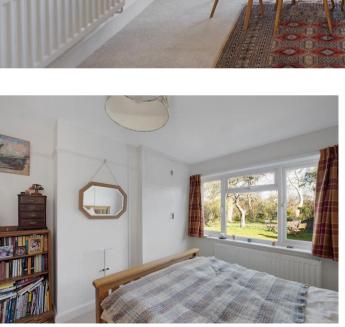
Location
